# What has WAIA done in the 12 months since last year's AGM?

#### 1. Launched IX Australia

- WAIA is an incorporated association, runs on a not for profit basis and is operated for the benefit of its members.
- IX Australia is a registered business name of the Western Australian Internet Association (Inc.)
- WAIA delivers products and services under the IX Australia brand.

"IX Australia is the independent not-for-profit Internet Peering Exchange service operated for members across Australia by the WA Internet Association. It is commercially-neutral, carrierneutral and ISP independent."

#### 2. Increased and Improved Peering Services

- WAIA started the year with WAIX, VICIX and QLDIX
- We have 6 POPs in Perth at the moment, 2 in Melbourne, 3 in Brisbane, 2 in Sydney and 2 POP locations in Adelaide. Also looking at additional locations for other POPs in Sydney, Brisbane and Melbourne.

#### Started Peering in SA: SA-IX

- Launched SA-IX in Feb 13. Located in two sites in central Adelaide: Mile End South and Franklin St.
   Initial peers Adam Internet, Hostexpress, Cinenet, Hostworks
- SA-IX: 14 active, 1 in provisioning. Currently still in trial mode

#### Started Peering in NSW: NSW-IX

- Launched in early July 2013. Also launched use of IX-Australia in Sydney. Had launch event in Sydney on 10 July 2013
- Main NSW-IX POP located at Equinix SY1/SY2 in Mascot
  - Foundation peers: AARNet, Anticlockwise,
    Cine.net, Cloudfare, Highwinds, RWTS,
    Simtronic, Virtutel, Vocus, Yahoo, and Zettanet
  - Provisioning peers Akamai, Ultraserve, Pacnet, Exetel, Skymesh and Service Elements.
  - Large content providers peering in NSW-IX include Highwinds, Edgecast, Google, Yahoo, Microsoft, Primus/M2, iiNet, Amazon Web Services
- IX Australia launched NSW-IX second POP at Global Switch Ultimo in August 2013, we already have NetRegistry, Ultraserve & Anchor peering and more in the pipeline.
- NSW-IX: 34 active, 6 in provisioning.

#### **Set Price Parity**

 Introduced Price Parity in August (for September services). IX Australia now has same consistent Peering prices for all IXs across Australia.

#### 3. Launched WA Data Centre for Members

 Storeroom 2 in QV1 Basement, Perth is now fitted out as data centre. Limited rackspace is now available for Colo services. Joe will advise more details and pricing in his report.

 Conducted extensive review of the WAIA
